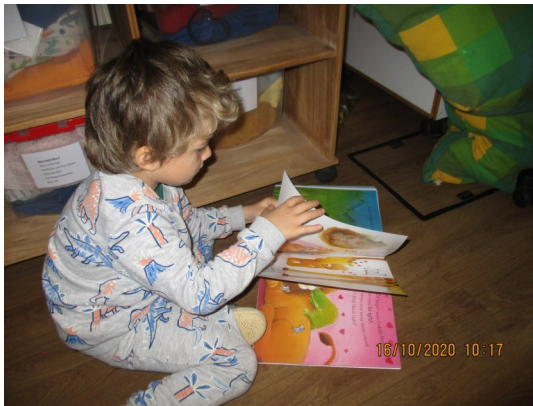


What if our home language isn't English?

Reading is the most important thing you can do to help your child at home. It paves the way to success in school, which can build self-confidence and motivate your child to set high expectations for life.



Here are some tips:

Reading is Fun— Read different books, use different Voices, act out the story. Read, and re-read their favorite stories and encourage your child to join in too.



Read Every Day—Children love routine, and reading is something that you and your child can look forward to every day. Make a special place that you can enjoy books together.

Talk about Books— What did they think of the story? What would they like to read?

Listen to your child re-tell stories— Even before your child is able to read a story they will be able to remember stories you have read them and share them with you.



Set an Example As a parent, you are your child's most important role model. If your child sees you reading, especially for pleasure or information, he or she will understand that reading is a worthwhile activity.
